2. Describe primary reasons for decision:

This panel recommends that funding be withheld until verifiable criteria are developed and implemented for target population of qualified low income elderly, disabled, and others for essential "life support rides". Panel is concerned about funding non-essential rides for "general population" and the lack of tracking of who pays and who does not pay for rides.

It would have been beneficial to have an accurate financial statement at the beginning of the process with explanations of large increases i.e. \$53000 increases in Salaries, Benefits, and Payroll taxes.

With increased emphasis on the "general population" paying their fair share and focusing United Way dollars on the target population the panel recommended decreasing the allocation to \$13540.
